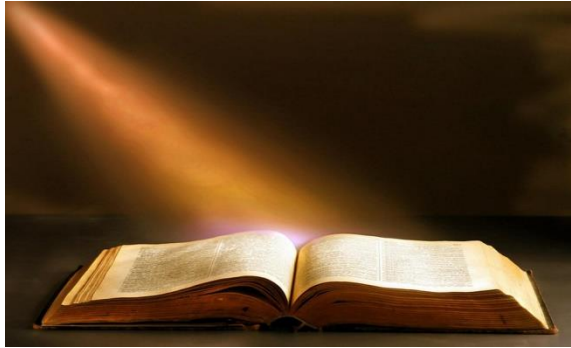
## THIS WEEK

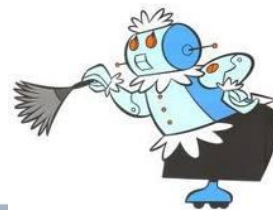
