

## Simple Seed Stitch Shawl

Total size should be about 20 inches wide and 60 – 72 inches long. It will take between 950-1050 yards of DK or Worsted weight yarn.

DK: With size 7 (4.5 mm) needles, cast on 90 stitches (or any equal number that makes the shawl 20” wide).

Worsted: With size 9 (5.5 mm) needles, cast on 80 stitches (or any equal number that makes the shawl 20” wide).

Row 1 (Right Side): \*Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): \*Purl 1, knit 1; repeat from \* to end of row.

Work until shawl measures 60 - 72 inches, bind off.

## Reversible Mock Cable Shawl

Total size should be about 20 inches wide and 60 – 72 inches long. It will take between 950-1050 yards of DK or Worsted weight yarn.

DK: With size 7 (4.5 mm) needles, cast on 88 stitches (or any multiple of 12 + 4 edge stitches to make the shawl 20” wide).

Worsted: With size 9 (5.5 mm) needles, cast on 76 stitches (or any multiple of 12 + 4 edge stitches to make the shawl 20” wide).

Work four rows garter stitch (knit every stitch).

Begin mock cable pattern:

Row 1: K2, \*p5, k1, p1, k5; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 2: K2, \*p4, k2, p2, k4; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 3: K2, \*p3, k3; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 4: K2, \*p2, k3, p1, k1, p3, k2; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 5: K2, \*p1, k3, p2, k2, p3, k1; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 6: K2, \*k3, p3; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 7: K2, \*k2, p4, k4, p2; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Row 8: K2, \*k1, p5, k5, p1; repeat from \* until 2 stitches remain, k2.

Repeat rows 1-8 until about half an inch short of total desired length. Work four rows garter stitch. Bind off.
