A Word from the Rector

On Wednesday, November 3rd at 7 pm we will be holding a Special Vestry Meeting by Zoom - details for the Zoom link will be sent closer to the date.

Typically, Special Vestries are limited to one item; however, the bishop has given his approval to include two agenda items to avoid the need to call a second meeting. The agenda items are:

1. Budget Update/Presentation and Acceptance of the Audited Financial Statements for the past two years.
2. Presentation and Approval of Renovations to the Basement area of the Church – this is to accommodate a day school as a new long-term tenant.

As you are aware, St Simon's Shelter has relocated to the former Isabella Hotel. We therefore need to find a long-term tenant and have discerned that a school is appropriate at this time. Over the past 19 months our parish leadership has been working extraordinarily hard to deal with this and other challenging issues. Vestry approval is the next step in the process of entering into a tenancy agreement in advance of this being presented to the Executive Committee of the Diocese.

On behalf of the parish, I extend our gratitude to Johan van 't Hof who is steering this process, to the Wardens and others who are giving so generously of their time and expertise.



2022 Church Calendars



FaithWorks

We turn our attention once again to the Diocese of Toronto's FaithWorks campaign. This parish has faithfully contributed to the worthy causes supported by FaithWorks and the Stewardship Committee thanks parishioners for their contributions that have totaled \$3,090 over the last three years.



This year marks the 25th anniversary of FaithWorks. Over these years, funds have been raised that provide much needed support for worthy initiatives within the Toronto Diocese such as those that address homelessness; work with ex-prisoners, newcomers and refugees; with at-risk women, children and youth; as well as working with indigenous people and those who are impacted by HIV-AIDS.

To celebrate the 25th anniversary, a generous donor from within the Diocese has offered a \$100,000 matching challenge grant for all new and increased donations. This means that for every dollar raised over last year's amount by a parish, FaithWorks will receive an extra dollar.
