#### A Word from the Rector

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Today we are delighted to welcome guest preacher, the Reverend Canon Judy Herron Graham. Judy is past Rector of St Peter's Carlton Street and most recently, retired Rector of St George's Oshawa - Welcome Judy.

It is great news for our neighbours and for us, that the Homework Club (a shared ministry with Rosedale Presbyterian and St Andrew's united) has resumed. It operates Monday to Friday from 3 to 6 pm in our Parish Hall. A new Coordinator has been hired and volunteers are returning to help provide support and guidance to the children who come to us. More volunteers are welcome – please speak with me if you are interested in helping.

You will notice fencing has been put up on the south side of the Church. This is due to the construction work that is commencing to accommodate the new Munchkin Manor daycare which will take up residence in the new year.

This morning, our final hymn is the well-known and rousing "He who would valiant be", known also as "To Be a Pilgrim" or the "Pilgrim Hymn". It is an English hymn using words of John Bunyan in *The Pilgrim's Progress*, written in 1684. It recalls the words of Hebrews 11:13: "...and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth." As a brief aside, this is the school hymn for St Clement's School in North Toronto. I remember well a packed church of girls singing this lustily (with no changes to the text) when I served there! It is sung to the tune *Monk's Gate*, named after a small town in West Sussex. The music is based on a local folk melody and adapted by Ralph Vaughan Williams.

This week I will be away in the United Kingdom to attend a family funeral. Canon Greg Carpenter will celebrate on Wednesday at 11 am and Officiate at Choral Evensong on Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup> at 4.00 pm. Fr Christopher Dangpilen will Celebrate on Sunday morning at the 10.30 am Choral Eucharist.


