Dear Parishioners and Friends,

For many years our parish has partnered with Rosedale Presbyterian Church and St Andrew's United Church to provide an afterschool homework club ministry. This has sadly been suspended for the last two years due to covid restrictions which has left a big gap in the lives of the families from St Jamestown who rely strongly on the support we provide. I am delighted to announce that the Homework Club will be starting up again on Monday, October 17th. It will operate Monday to Friday from 3 to 6 pm in our Parish Hall. A new Coordinator has been hired and volunteers are returning to help provide support and guidance to the children who come to us. More volunteers are welcome – please speak with me if you are interested in helping.

You will notice fencing has been put up on the south side of the Church. This is due to the construction work that is commencing to accommodate the new Munchkin Manor daycare which will take up residence in the new year.

We have some guest preachers coming over the next few weeks. On October 16th we welcome back to SPSS the Reverend Canon Beth Benson, and on Sunday, October 23rd we welcome the Reverend Canon Judy Herron Graham, former Rector of St Peter's Carleton Street and most recently, retired Rector of St George's Oshawa.

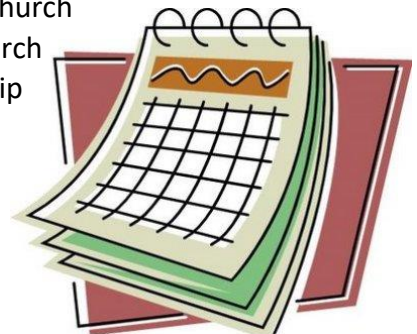

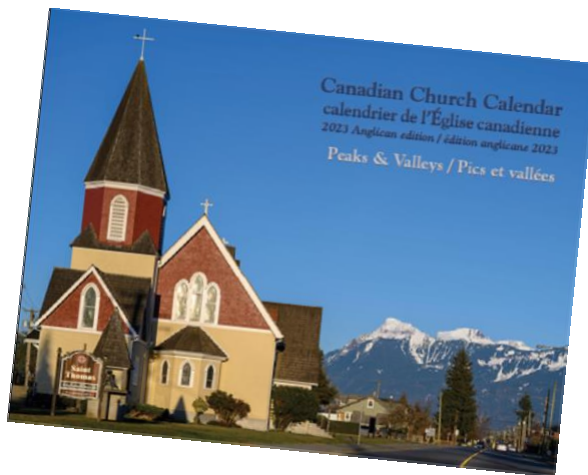
