A Word From the Rector

The Fourth Sunday in Lent is sometimes known as *Refreshment Sunday*, a title probably suggested by the original Gospel for this day, Jesus Feeding the Multitudes, St John 6.1. Some people will also know this day as *Mothering Sunday*, the origin of which is uncertain, but possibly coming from the traditional epistle reading, Galatians 4.26 which reads "Jerusalem which is above is free; which is the Mother of us all". If you refer to page 147 of the Prayer Book you will see those readings appointed for this day.

Most parishes now use the Revised Common Lectionary which means we don't have the direct scriptural references to refreshment or mothering. Nevertheless, the readings today speak to the theme in their own way by focussing on the image of light. David the Shepherd boy is anointed King of Israel and thus becomes the one to lead his people from darkness to light. Paul addresses the Ephesians as children of light. In the Gospel a blind man is healed by Jesus and regains his sight. At this mid-point in our Lenten journey the Church invites us to open our eyes more widely to the light of Christ. We pick up the cross knowing it is a journey that leads to Good Friday and ultimately to Easter resurrection.

Looking ahead, I am planning to hold a scripture Study on St John's Gospel. A central theme in John is light in the darkness. This will take place on a weekday morning or afternoon which I will confirm shortly.

Take some time this week to dwell on the many ways that Christ's light shines. Be refreshed by his grace and know that, as a loving mother holds and cares for her child, so too we are held and cared for by the one who breaks the darkness. Have a wonderful week...and enjoy the light! Geoffrey+
