Brief History of Hymn 106, There's a Voice in the Wilderness

James Lewis Milligan (1876-1961) was born in Liverpool. Emigrating to Ontario in 1911, he worked as a Methodist pastor. He worked as a newspaper editor and public relations agent from 1913 to 1937 when he opened a public relations firm in Toronto. Milligan wrote speeches for Mackenzie King. He wrote this hymn in 1925 to celebrate the founding of the United Church of Canada. He interpreted the words of Isaiah as a call to the new church. This hymn is associated with St John the Baptist. We usually sing it in Advent, but we sing it today as this is the Sunday in the Octave of the Nativity of St John the Baptist whose feast is June 24th.
