Hymn Note for Hail to the Lord's Anointed (CP # 101)

James Montgomery (1771-1854), the son of a Moravian minister, was born in Ayrshire. He began writing for the Sheffield newspaper in 1794 and took over as editor when the previous editor fled the country. Montgomery was a man of strong convictions, maintaining man's right to freedom of thought. He was jailed in York Castle for publishing a poem celebrating the fall of the Bastille. He espoused many humanitarian causes, denouncing the slave trade and advocating for chimney sweeps. After 1814, he took an active interest in Methodism and a chapel in Sheffield bears his name. He wrote more than 400 hymns. He assisted Thomas Cotterill, rector of St. Paul's, Sheffield, in producing an edition of Cotterill's hymn book (1816). Montgomery contributed 50 hymns. Montgomery wrote "Angels from the Realms of Glory." and "Songs of Praise the Angels Sang." Today's hymn was written in 1821 as a Christmas ode for a Moravian settlement.

"Blue Christmas" Service on Wednesday, December 18 at 6:30 p.m.

While most people look forward to the Christmas season, we acknowledge that there are also those for whom Christmas is not a happy time, people who — for various reasons — approach Christmas with sadness or even dread, people whose Christmases are more blue than white.

Beginning in about 1990 in North America, many parishes have offered "Blue Christmas" services, quiet and contemplative occasions of healing and hope, as an alternative to the more traditional gatherings. These are generally held close to the Winter Solstice, "The Longest Night", and this year St. Peter and St. Simon-the-Apostle will be hosting a "Blue Christmas" service at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 18, for those in sadness and pain, those who are stressed, lonely or grieving, people struggling with unhappy memories or who find this season difficult to cope with for any reason at all.

Please come and support our "Blue Christmas" service on December 18 even if Christmas is your favourite time of the year. Your attendance will help to provide a safe and accepting place for our brothers and sisters who are not so fortunate. Not everybody in pain is comfortable with sharing their feelings, and it is a loving thing to do to be supportive of them. We need to gather as a whole community, surrounded by love, to listen to God's word, remember God's promises, and to praise God who is the source of all light and hope. A time of refreshment and fellowship will follow the service.

Please keep this service and those for whom it is intended in your prayers and join us on December 18 if you possibly can.
