Special Vestry Today | There will be a special vestry meeting regarding the 2024 financials and 2025 budget today after the service.



Hymn Notes: O Glorious Day (CP # 253)

John Richard Peacey (1896-1971) was born in Sussex. He won the Military Cross in World War I. He received honours in theology from Selwyn College, Cambridge (1921), and then became dean of the college. In 1927, he became principal of Bishop Cotton School in Simla, India. Then in 1936, he became principal o Bishop's College, Calcutta. After the war, he returned to England and was made a canon at Bristol Cathedral. He wrote only 18 hymns and these were published posthumously in 1991.

John Wainwright ((1723-68) was born in Stockport, Cheshire, and moved to Manchester in 1746. He was organist at Manchester Collegiate Church (later Manchester Cathedral). There he took a leading part in the musical life of the city and the surrounding area. Even though several of his fingers had been dislocated and rendered useless by a man with a grudge, Wainwright continued to perform with remarkable skill. He wrote the tune YORKSHIRE to accompany a Christmas carol by his friend John Byrom, "Christians, awake, salute the happy morn." Byrom reported that the choir under the direction of Wainwright performed the carol on Christmas 1750.
