Please join us for refreshments in the Parish Hall following the 10.30 am service.


## Advent Bible Study: Behold the Messiah

This four-week Advent Bible study explores the scriptural and theological foundations of Part One of Handel's *Messiah*. Participants will listen to key musical movements, read the related biblical passages, and reflect on how the themes of prophecy, incarnation, redemption, and kingship shape our Advent and Christmas faith.

Tuesdays, 6:00–8:30 p.m, Light Potluck in the Hall, Discussion to follow in the Sitting Room.

### Hymn Notes: Stand Up and Bless the Lord (CP # 350)

James Montgomery (1771-1854), the son of a Moravian minister, was born in Ayrshire. He began writing for the Sheffield newspaper in 1794 and took over as editor when the previous editor fled the country. Montgomery was a man of strong convictions, maintaining man's right to freedom of thought. He was jailed in York Castle for publishing a poem celebrating the fall of the Bastille. He espoused many humanitarian causes, denouncing the slave trade and advocating for chimney sweeps. After 1814, he took an active interest in Methodism and a chapel in Sheffield bears his name. He wrote more than 400 hymns, including 50 he contributed to an 1816 hymn book edited by Thomas Cotterill, rector of St. Paul's, Sheffield. Today's hymn was written in 1824 for the anniversary service of the Sheffield Red Hill Wesleyan Sunday School.

ST. THOMAS, attributed to Aaron Williams (1731-76), was published in his *New Universal Psalmodist* (1770). There the tune as set to Psalm 48. Born in London, Williams was an engraver and a music teacher. He was also clerk of London Wall Scots Church. He edited many collections of church music.


