Please join us for refreshments in the Parish Hall following the 10.30 am service.


## Advent Bible Study: Behold the Messiah

This four-week Advent Bible study explores the scriptural and theological foundations of Part One of Handel's *Messiah*. Participants will listen to key musical movements, read the related biblical passages, and reflect on how the themes of prophecy, incarnation, redemption, and kingship shape our Advent and Christmas faith.

### Hymn Notes: Judge Eternal, Throned in Splendour (CP # 594)

Henry Scott Holland (1847-1918) was born in Herefordshire. He graduated from Oxford and was ordained in 1872. He was interested in the social implications of the Gospel. A founder of the Christian Social Union, he was the editor of their publication, *The Commonwealth*, for 22 years. In 1884, he was made a canon of St. Paul's Cathedral on the recommendation of Gladstone. In 1911, he was made professor of divinity at Oxford. His interest in music led him to assist in the preparation of *The English Hymnal (1906)*. He was also co-author of a book on Jenny Lind. This, his only hymn, was published in 1902. It reflects the social problems that confronted the Church in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. RHUDDLAN was first published in Edward Jones' *Musical Relicks of the Welsh Bards (1784)*. Rhuddlan is located in North Wales on the River Clwd. The town name comes from the red soil along the bank. This is the site of the conflict that ended Queen Boadicea's revolt in 43 A.D. The 11<sup>th</sup> century Rhuddlan Castle was made a place of refuge by Edward I in 1277.


